- The formulation and invoicing of Community Usage Charges, the annual charges collected from owners and sub-developers in a Master Project for the management, operation, maintenance and repair of common facilities, are regulated by Law 6 of 2019.
- The Jumeirah Islands Master Community Usage Charge is reviewed and approved by regulating authorities – both Ports, Customs and Free Zone Corporation (PCFC) and the Real Estate Regulatory Agency (RERA).
- In line with our efforts to share regular updates, we would like to inform you that the community budget has been shared with the relevant authority for approval and your Service Charge invoice for 2022 will be issued once the budget has been approved.
- The 2022 community usage charge will remain nominally the same as 2021. Further details of the 2022 community usage charge breakdown will be provided along with the invoice.
- Invoicing for 2022 community usage charges will occur once approval of the relevant authorities is received.
- For your convenience, we have temporarily waived late payment fees
 when service charge is paid in full. You can settle your charges online via
 Nakheel Online Services or through the My Nakheel mobile app, which
 can be downloaded using the icons below.
- 2023 Budget preparations have started and will be submitted to the authorities shortly.




Landscaping improvements along centre median and adjacent right-of-way is in progress. Completion by the end of January 2023
