Recently Completed Improvements

Landscaping

- Plantation of 325 Washingtonias along the main driveway as communicated in our First Edition of Enhancement works
- Soil preparation works for the Fruit Farm to be located between Clusters 19 & 20
- Replantation of 3.5m Washingtonia Palm trees by Clusters 26 & 27 and preparation of soil for additional greenery to be planted in the same location, as communicated in the First Edition

Infrastructure

- Installation of 5 wet wells between Clusters 7 & 12 to mitigate rising ground water levels
- Continuing Lakes Treatment using Effective Microorganisms (EM) technology from Japan, in which natural microbes (lactic acid, yeast and phototrophic bacteria) are used to improve the quality of the water. The treatment is supplemented by the use of mudballs, made of fermented soil, to break down the sludge. Together, these treatments work to improve water quality, and reduce algae and foam formation.

Facilities

- Replacement of sail shades in all 3 parks
- Installation of football nets in Cluster 22 park, as communicated in the First Edition

Improvements in Progress

Landscaping

• Soil preparation works have commenced for Phase 2 of the landscaping improvements program on the areas surrounding the newly planted Washingtonia palm trees and on the sides of the right-of-way along the main drive running through Jumeriah Islands. The program is divided into 16 sections, with works starting from all three gates and winding their way inwards towards the centre of Jumeirah Islands. Your patience and caution while driving within the community next to the landscaping works in progress is appreciated.

Infrastructure

- Wayfinding signage upgrade throughout the community is in progress and expected to be completed by end of September.
- Trench-digging for the installation of cabling required to power the 29 aerators that will be installed in October as part of the Lakes Treatment program have commenced. Inconvenience to residents will be minimal, with alternate footpaths provided in cases of extended trench-digging works.
- Electrification of the newly installed dewatering pumps between Clusters 7 & 12 is around the corner. Once powered, the area will be kept under observation before landscaping works commence in the zone, to ensure the soil conditions are favourable for greenery to take hold.
- Partial fencing replacement along walkways close to Jumeirah Islands Townhouses is in progress

Facilities

• The replacement of the existing Astroturf in the Cluster 22 park is in progress, with ground compaction having been completed. New Astroturf will be installed by the end of August. We look forward to seeing football activities taking place in the refreshed Cluster 22 Park facilities when cooler weather prevails.

Planned Improvements

Landscaping

- Plantation of greenery along the centre median and adjacent to the right-of-way along the main driveway throughout Jumeriah Islands
- Plantation of trees at the Fruit Farm by Clusters 19& 20 is planned for October
- Plantation of additional greenery between Clusters 26 & 27 around the recently planted Washingtonias
- Plantation of Washingtonia palm trees along the centre median between Cluster 7 & 12, once the dewatering project is fully completed.

Infrastructure

- The 29 aerators that are part of the Lakes Treatment program have arrived from the US and will be installed in late October
- New u-shaped bollards will be installed in October at T-junctions close to the lakes

Facilities

- The Teqball table and flooring works installation at the Rowdha Park between Clusters 43 & 45 will be completed by early October, once ambient temperatures allow for the enjoyment of outdoor facilities.
- A drone survey of Jumeirah Islands will take place in September once the relevant approvals are obtained. We will notify residents in advance of the drone flyovers.

Removal of existing Astroturf & ground compaction completed; installation of new Astroturf by 29.08.2022




Phase 1 of Landscaping Enhancements was completed and Phase 2 has commenced, focusing on the centre median and right-of-way landscaping



The works will be done in 16 sections, starting from all three gates and continuing inwards



Soil preparations works are in progress at Gate 1. Planting will commence in October when the temperatures drop slightly.



The phase 2 landscaping project will be completed by January 2023. A mockup is already in place at the Gate 3 area.

Teqball table and flooring installation works will take place in the park by Clusters 43 & 45




Sail shades posts & canopies in all 3 parks were refreshed

Current clarity of one of the lakes since the biological-based, Japanese EM technology treatment has commenced




Effective Microorganisms (EM) treatment in progress in JI

Irrigation and soil preparations are completed for the Fruit Farm, coming up in October 2022.




The footpath installations will commence in September.
